Dr. Seyedmohammad (Omid) Pourshahid, is an assistant professor of Clinical Thoracic Medicine and Surgery at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University. He completed an Internal Medicine residency in the Mount Sinai program at Queen's hospital, followed by pulmonary and critical care fellowship at Virginia Tech Carilion School of Medicine. He concentrated his public health studies on behavioral health promotion. Dr. Pourshahid, currently serves as the medical director of pulmonary rehabilitation at Temple Hospital main campus in Philadelphia, PA. He has many publications and received grant support for his research in pulmonary rehabilitation.
